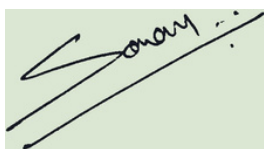
OUR STORY

VISION

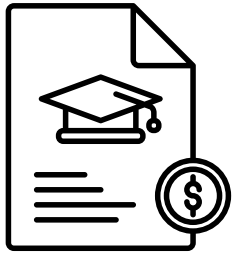

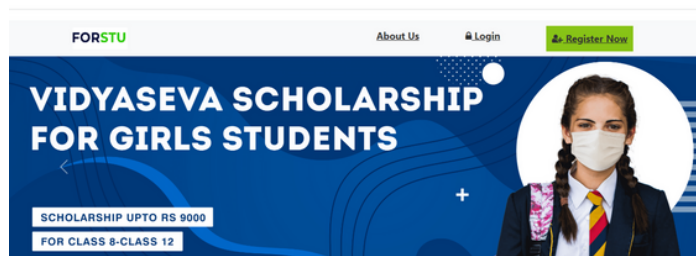
KEY ACTIVITIES



Education Mobility Program

The Education Mobility Program is dedicated to empowering students from challenging backgrounds by offering them academic opportunities to pursue their career aspirations and build a brighter future. Through this initiative, students gain knowledge about educational scholarships, fellowships, vocational skills, and soft skills provided by government bodies, civil society organizations, corporate CSR initiatives, High Net Worth Individuals (HNIs), and academic institutions.

- *Mobilized 1500+ students from Maharashtra, Delhi, and Uttar Pradesh to apply for scholarship programs offered by corporates*
- *200 students were awarded scholarships through DBT (Direct Benefit Transfer) to pursue secondary education*

Ghat Ki Pathshala



This initiative was established on the ghats of Varanasi to provide foundational education to children who were previously engaged in begging by posing as deity idols to attract tourists for alms. These children had never attended formal schooling, and their parents showed little interest, as the prevailing belief in India often equates more hands with higher begging income. The program commenced in January 2023 with 10 children and ran until March 2023.

Book Exchange Program



An initiative to help educate the underprivileged in collaboration with Inch Paper Pvt. Ltd with a mission to collect and organize resources to bring literacy and education to the poor. Protsahan Volunteers motivated colleagues, and housing societies to contribute to this beautiful mission to make India more literate. They were asked to donate their textbooks and notebooks which have a few blank sheets left in them and old used books which may not be useful for them in the future along with other used school supplies.

- *Mobilized 50 Volunteers from Mumbai, Delhi, and Uttar Pradesh to run this campaign and contributed 1000 books for better use.*

WASH Program in Schools



Collaborated with NGO- Manorath Foundation in implementing the WASH Program at Rajikya Inter College, Varanasi funded by the CSR initiative of Toyota. Protsahan's team strategized the implementation plan and mobilized volunteers to conduct a Health and hygiene awareness Program. This Program covered 500 girl students.

- *Trained 500 girls on the Wash Program in 2 govt schools of Varanasi*
- *Conducted 6 various engagements to impart and influence children & teachers' behaviors on various aspects of WASH.*



Step to Empowerment Program

This initiative was conceived to offer volunteering opportunities for urban residents to discover and engage in diverse collaborations facilitated by Protsahan.

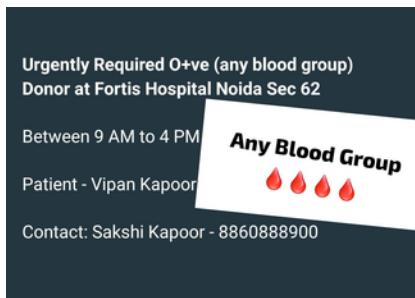
#Making ways of change
